

In 1925, President Calvin Coolidge presided over the dedication of the magnificent Jewish Community Center at 16th and Q Streets NW. Fully renovated in 1997, the Washington DCJCC's Irwin P. Edlavitch building is now both a beautiful historic structure and a modern facility offering a wide variety of gathering places to satisfy the needs of your organization.

Located in Dupont Circle within walking distance of the White House, National Geographic Society and a wide variety of cultural and dining destinations. The Dupont Circle Metro station and several main bus routes are also within easy reach. The Washington DCJCC building is equipped with excellent spaces for award presentations, annual meetings, sales presentations, conferences, receptions, luncheons, cocktail parties and seminars. The five-story, 60,000 square foot facility is fully wheelchair accessible and open to all.

**Metro:** Take the red line to Dupont Circle. Use the Q Street exit and turn right. Walk four blocks east to 16th and Q Streets.

**Bus:** Use the S series north-south bus on 16th Street or G2 east-west bus on P Street.

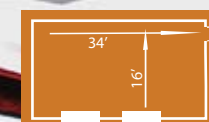

## HYMAN S. AND FREDA BERNSTEIN LIBRARY

Maximum occupancy: 30  
Dimensions: 34'x16' or 544 square feet

The library, situated conveniently off the main lobby, serves as a serene, intimate location for meetings of all kinds. The large windows allow natural light and face Q Street.



## INA AND JACK KAY COMMUNITY HALL

Maximum occupancy: 150  
Dimensions: 46'x33' or 1,518 square feet

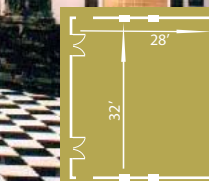
Adjacent to the Q Street entrance to the building, this is one of our largest spaces. The Community Hall is an ideal location for receptions, large meetings, weddings, lectures or seminars. The large windows allow natural light and face Q Street. A large adjacent kitchen offers convenient food preparation or full catering service.



## ELIZABETH M. AND DAVID BRUCE SMITH 16<sup>TH</sup> STREET LOBBY

Maximum occupancy: 80  
Dimensions: 32'x28' or 896 square feet

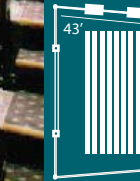
Spacious and well lit, this lobby has been completely restored to its original splendor. With its original marble floor and marble columns, as well as faux-mahogany ceiling beams, the lobby is an excellent location for honoring special guests, VIP receptions and after-work social gatherings. Facing 16th Street, the outside staircase leading to the lobby creates a striking entrance.



## AARON & CECILE GOLDMAN THEATER

Maximum occupancy: 250  
Dimensions: 53'x43' or 2,279 square feet

The elegant eggplant, bronze and cerise theater offers 214 fixed seats in the orchestra and an additional 44 seats in the side balconies. A front row of seats can also be added to reach a maximum capacity of 250. The auditorium is steeply raked, ensuring unobstructed views from every seat. Seats are extra-wide, with three feet between rows for maximum leg room.



## TAUBER FOUNDATION GYMNASIUM

Maximum occupancy: 250  
Dimensions: 67'x40' or 2,680 square feet

Perfect for pick-up games of basketball or volleyball or for organized team play, the gymnasium is used by business firms, schools and sports leagues alike. The spacious area is also ideal for large gatherings and events.



## CLASSROOMS

Maximum occupancy: 10-40  
Dimensions: 126-450 square feet

Five formal classrooms offer a variety of smaller spaces ideal for purposes such as conference break-out sessions, committee meetings, rehearsals and, of course, classes. Most offer large windows allowing plenty of natural light.
